



### **MIDI Designer 1.3 Released**

New York, NY (April 2012)—Confusionists LLC is pleased to announce MIDI Designer for iPad version 1.3, now available in both Pro and Lite (free) versions in the App Store. MIDI Designer is more than just the perfect MIDI controller—it’s also the ultimate hardware-software hybrid.

In Design Mode, MIDI Designer is a platform to create the perfect MIDI controller. The user adds and customizes pages, laying out knobs, sliders, buttons, X-Y pads and other controls. Controls can send and receive all standard MIDI message types (including NRPN and sysex) and be linked in multiple ways, including as super- and subcontrols.

In Performance Mode, the perfect MIDI controller comes alive over a sub-5ms Wifi or hardware connection. The two-up page display lets the user mix and match different parts of their rig flexibly and intuitively. Knob and slider overlays [patent pending] solve the classic touch-interface problem: the “Your-Finger-Is-Not-See-Through” Problem.

MIDI Designer is the first in the new generation of hardware-software hybrids. The “Pedalboard” feature pushes the user’s hardware MIDI controller across the virtual divide. The user can control all aspects of a multi-page rig in MIDI Designer from one or more external MIDI controllers.

Version 1.3 adds several new features and smaller enhancements, including:

- Channel changers, giving users another option for multifunction controls
- Button groups (aka “radio buttons”)
- Tall sliders and longer throw lengths for greater precision

MIDI Designer’s primary use is for music makers—musicians, DJs and sound engineers—who want to surpass the limits of hardware MIDI controllers.
